DAY2. Early start for a 154 km drive from Mount Barker to Keith.

DAY3. Dimboola is our destination for day three another 168 km; the team will be getting well-oiled by now.

DAY4. Dimboola to Ararat 131 km's with a planned community event put on by the SES and the RC of Ararat. Staying the night in the local SES HQ.

- **DAY5.** Ballarat is only a short 94 km today and the local police are escorting us through town. That should turn a few heads.
- **DAY6.** Ballarat to Melbourne with a lunch stopover in Melton before the overnight Ferry trip to Tasmania.
- **DAY7.** Early arrival and BBQ brekkie with the community put on by the RC of Devonport before setting off to Burnie. The overnight is at one of the local schools.
- **DAY8.** Off to Oatlands a big day so an early start will be needed another 190 km.
- **DAY9.** Oatlands to Hobart only 84 km then a display down at Constitution Dock.
- **DAY10.** Trailer trip back to Perth before we drive the last of our Km in Tasmania. Perth to Devonport and the overnight Ferry back to the main land.
- **DAY11.** Day off for the team with some sponsors visits, Media commitments and a service for the mower.

- DAY15. Seymour to Chiltern 175 km
- **DAY16.** Wagga Wagga and a big day of 190 km staying this night under the show grounds grand stand.
- DAY17. Yass 182 km a lot of hill on today's leg before our overnight in a shearing shed.
- **DAY18.** All downhill for today a shot 60 km run into Canberra and Parliament house.
- **DAY19.** Rest day to see the sights do some more, Media spots, sponsor's calls and by now a lot of washing.
- **DAY20.** Canberra to Mittagong police escort through town, some time to stop and talk with the community.
- **DAY21.** Rest day time to savour our efforts and plan for our final drive in to Parramatta then Olympic Park.
- DAY22. Mittagong to Parramatta and Rotary HQ.
